West Lafayette High School gets to award 1 scholarship from the Indiana Blood Center. All students must meet the following criteria to be eligible for the scholarship:

- Must be a graduating senior
- Must have participated in at least one blood drive during the 2017-2018 academic year at the school, either as a student coordinator/recruiter
- Must have recruited or hosted an Indiana Blood Center blood drive with at least 30 participating donors
- Student must provide a 250 word statement on what blood donation means to them
- Must be attending an institution of higher education in Indiana during academic year 2017-2018

Turn in a digital copy of your 250 word statement to Ms. Huckstep via e-mail (huckstepk@wl.k12.in.us) by Tuesday, April 17th to be eligible. See Ms. Huckstep if you have questions.

Part 2 of the grade 10 ISTEP will take place on Monday, April 23 during periods 1-5 and 7. Students will be testing in the high school gym, unless otherwise specified. Please be sure to bring your school ID with you on test day.
